Accurately identifies substances involved in overdoses.



Provides near real-time drug trend data and insights.

The MDH Public Health Lab performs expanded toxicology testing to definitively identify over **1,300 substances** in residual clinical specimens.



Nearly **7 in 10** acute substance misuse visits are missed with traditional hospital-based surveillance.

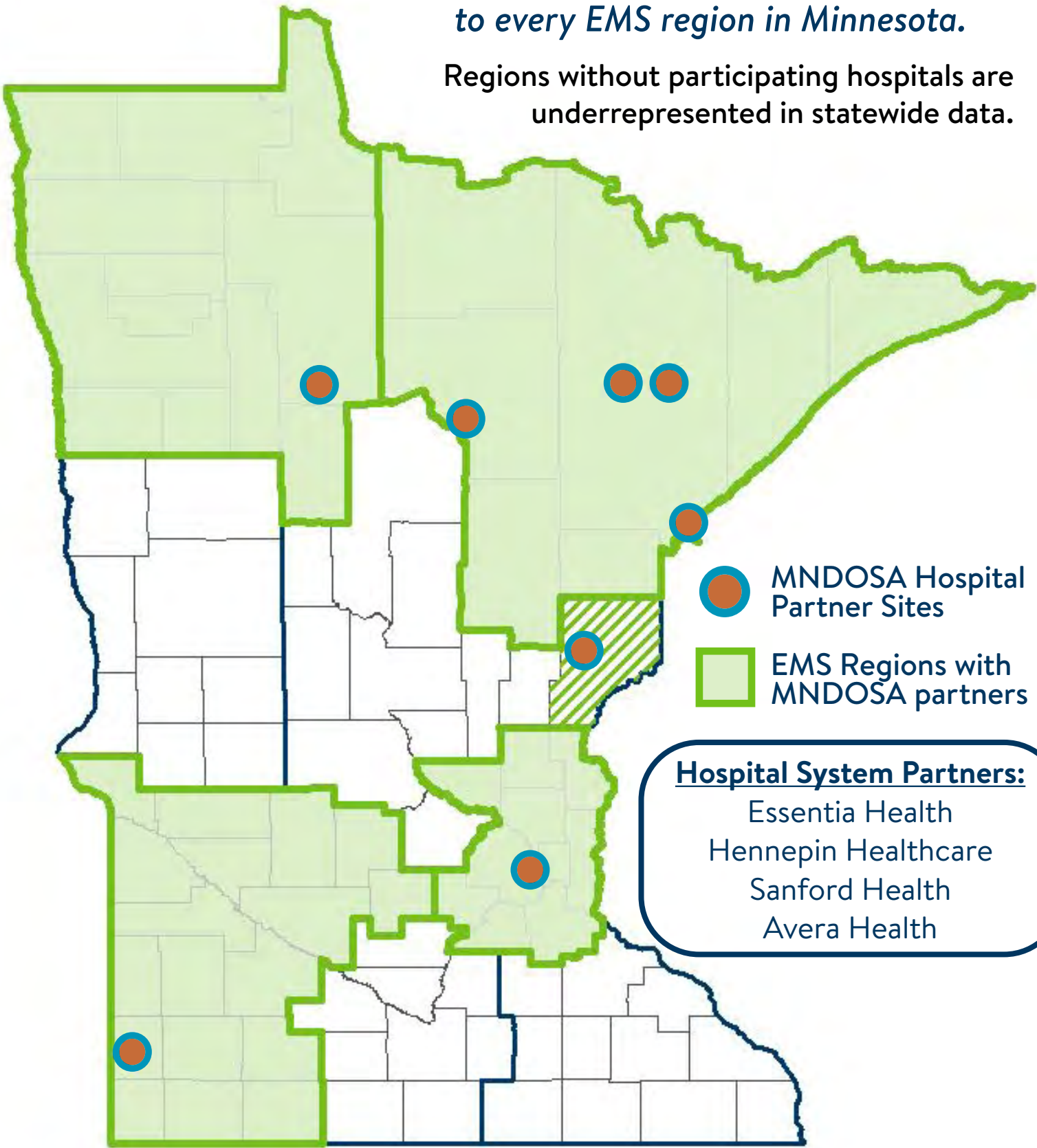
