A radon test kit can keep one family safe



A radon testing program that includes monitoring rates and education to the community strengthens the population

Foundational

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Living in a nome with Colorado's average radon level is like having 200 chest A-rays a year.
Colorado ranks 45th among all states for the percent of radon test results that are above the EPA action level.

Radon is a naturally-occurring radioactive gas with no color, odor, or taste. Radon can easily enter homes and other buildings through small openings like cracks in foundations, openings around pumps and drains, and crawl spaces. We conduct Community Health Assessments that may show Radon as a major issue, needing community education efforts
