Our conversation takeaways:

In response to the query about moving our community partnerships to a better place, more authenticity, more trust, deeper collaboration, and increasing sustainability:

- Be intentional in meeting with community partners to go beyond general updates to meaningful discussion and authentic shared planning
- Tap into FPHR funding to expand the work with community partners and deepen the shared work
- Be authentic in sharing: don't overburden community partners but rather accept their contributions and talents <u>while</u> admitting where we in public health might fall short or have less knowledge or understanding
- Invest in community partnerships for long-term relationships, progress over multiple cycles, and sustainability collaboration
- Allow time and space for open conversations where ideas and needs can bubble up
- Take time to go where the partners are, sharing their concerns and successes rather than centering everything on what public health needs
