
Tobacco Use in Minnesota: 1999 to 2007

## **Final 2007 National Prevalence Rate**

December 2008

Since the release of the 2007 Minnesota Adult Tobacco Survey findings in September 2008, the 2007 National Health Interview Survey (NHIS) smoking prevalence rate has been updated. The following figure has been updated to reflect the final 2007 NHIS rate of 19.8 percent. All NHIS rates reported here are non-age adjusted rates. 1,2
