On August 27, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approved COVID-19 vaccines for the 2025-2026 season manufactured by Moderna, Pfizer, and Sanofi/Novavax. In addition, the FDA revoked the Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) for Novavax COVID-19 vaccine, adjuvanted; Moderna COVID-19 vaccine, and Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine.

Due to the revocation of EUAs, 2024-2025 COVID-19 products should no longer be administered effective **immediately**. MnVFC providers should:

- Remove the 2024-2025 vaccines from their storage units.
- Label them "do not use".
- Report them as nonviable in MIIC, even if they are not expired.

This applies to all presentations of 2024-2025 COVID-19 vaccines, including products for ages 6 months-11 years of age and 12 years of age and older.

We will make 2025-2026 COVID-19 vaccines available through the MnVFC program when it is on the federal contract after the upcoming ACIP meeting Sept. 18-19. Keep an eye out for more information from us after that meeting regarding ordering.
