RSV vaccination for pregnant teens

RSV vaccination of pregnant people is recommended during weeks 32-36 of pregnancy between September and January in Minnesota and most of the continental U.S.

Pfizer's pediatric RSV vaccine, Abrysvo, is the only product available for vaccination of pregnant teens. You can continue to administer Abrysvo to pregnant teens through the end of the month. After Jan. 29, Abrysvo will no longer be available to order through the MnVFC program until next season.

RSV monoclonal antibody (RSV mAB) products for infants, clesrovimab and nirsevimab, will continue to be available to order through the MnVFC program until the end of March. You can place orders for these products in the regular ordering form in MIIC.

Flu vaccine prebook reminder

The prebook event to request influenza vaccine for the 2026-27 influenza season is now open. **Prebook requests are due Jan. 30.** Requests submitted after Jan. 30 will be considered late. Late requests can't be guaranteed and may arrive later in the season. Ordering for the current season (2025-26) will be temporarily unavailable while the 2026-27 prebook is open and will resume on Feb. 2.
