How to Use Printable Reports in MIIC

Client follow-up report

Used to identify a cohort of clients who are due or overdue for immunizations. Feature can be used for Childhood, Adolescent, or Adult Immunization Summary Report to target immunization improvement. Assessment report

Used to help monitor and measure immunization coverage rates for vaccines recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP). It can be used for quality improvement projects and to monitor the impact of practice changes. Vaccines given report

Generates a list of the vaccines that have been reported. This report can be sorted by vaccine group, date, associations, and age at vaccination. For a user guide visit <u>Vaccines Given Report</u> (www.health.state.mn.us/people/immunize/miic/train/givevax.pdf).

Vaccine administration record report

Displays the client's demographics and contact information, as well as immunizations available in the selected site. To access visit <u>Minnesota Immunization Information Connection (https://miic.health.state.mn.us/miic/)</u>.

Complete immunization report

Displays client demographics, contact information, and detailed immunization history. It can be used by providers seeking immunization-specific information such as vaccine product information, administered route, reactions to immunizations, and other provider information. Immunization report

Displays client demographics, contact information, and immunization history. It is best used for general immunization record documentation for the public. It contains information on vaccine product type, date, and name, as well as recommended immunizations and additional comments. Vaccine summary report

Generates an aggregate report of immunization reported to MIIC. This report is best for high-level checks that immunization data is accurately reported to MIIC, as well as for vaccine management and planning activities.
